RE: 2021-2022 Holy Days

Catholics are obliged to attend Holy Mass on the following *remaining* Holydays of Obligation in 2021:

Wednesday, December 8, 2021	Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception
Saturday, December 25, 2021	Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord

NOTE:

- In 2021, the Solemnity of All Saints falls on Monday, November 1. In keeping with the Saturday-Monday rule, it is not observed as a Holyday of Obligation. It remains a Solemnity and should be celebrated as such in our parishes; the faithful are encouraged to attend.

Catholics are obliged to attend Holy Mass on the following Holydays of Obligation in 2022:

Tuesday, November 1, 2022	Solemnity of All Saints
Thursday, December 8, 2022	Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception
Sunday, December 25, 2022	Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord

NOTE:

- In 2022, the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God, falls on Saturday, January 1. In keeping with the Saturday-Monday rule, it is not observed as a Holyday of Obligation. It remains a Solemnity and should be celebrated as such in our parishes; the faithful are encouraged to attend.
- In 2022, observance of the Ascension of Our Lord, Thursday, May 26, is transferred to the Seventh Sunday of Easter, May 29, 2022.
- In 2022, the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary falls on Monday, August 15. In keeping with the Saturday-Monday rule, it is not observed as a Holyday of Obligation. It remains a Solemnity and should be celebrated as such in our parishes; the faithful are encouraged to attend.
